



Empowering Youth through Media Literacy

The SLMS project developed the first result - the Service Learning Handbook, based on the results of focus groups organised by project partners in Spain, Romania and Poland. The focus groups were conducted in early autumn and gathered around 20 young professional facilitators from different sectors of education. The aim of the meetings was to identify the level of knowledge of our beneficiaries about service learning approaches and methods.



Discussions focused on the possible use of SL methods in their daily lives, and partners gathered information about the experiences of our beneficiaries. All this information formed the basis for the development of an advanced guide to service learning, which can be used by all stakeholders in their daily work.

MORE ABOUT OUR WORK

As a second step, we organised a second focus group meeting in partner countries to identify the level of knowledge about media literacy. These meetings were also dedicated to identifying the most needed topics that should be developed by the consortium to provide the most useful training content for our beneficiaries. These focus groups were held in October-November 2023 and, based on the feedback received from participants, we already have a joint report. Based on this report, we are starting to work on the training content.
